Changes at UIS:

UIS continues to thrive to improve school. Starting September, 2018, UIS is changing semesters to longer class time, but shorter term. School will begin at 9 am with three periods. This is a change from 10 am start and 4 courses a day. With the changed schedule, students will be taking less courses per term, while allowing them to complete more courses in one school year. As an end result, UIS students will benefit by lessened workload, and faster transition into their end-goal to post-secondary school. As for the ESL schedule, the program is now 10 weeks long (from 8 weeks), but their daily schedule will be shorter: students' daily schedule will start earlier, 9 am, and end at 3 pm, instead of 5 pm.

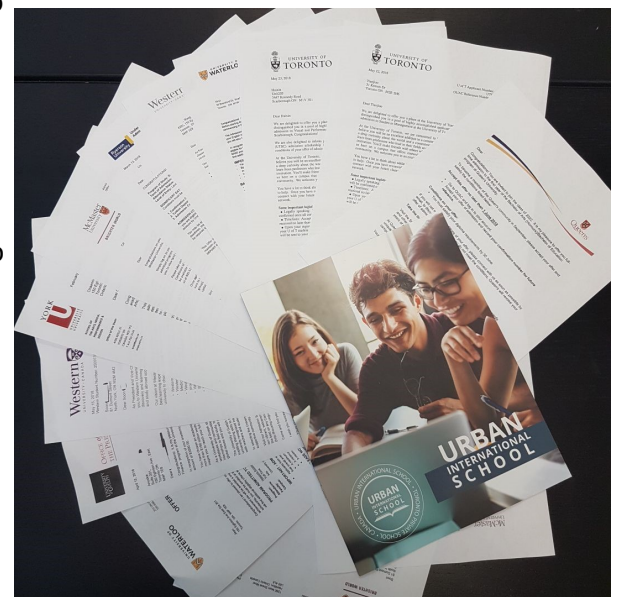
